In Brazil, Euroclima+ carries out actions to support public policies prioritized by the government, such as supporting the structuring of mechanisms for an industrial strategy to contribute to sustainable development in the country, in addition to other projects related to energy transition, urban mobility, bioeconomy, risk management and resilient food production.

One of the priority actions developed in the country seeks to develop a roadmap for an agricultural risk management strategy aimed at the resilience of family farmers. This will be done through a benchmarking analysis, meaning a survey of best practices around the world, as well as an assessment of risk management policies, programs and tools in Brazil. This analysis will generate the proposal of a roadmap for the Ministry of Economy and the Ministry of Agriculture, with the objective of developing a risk management strategy focused on family farmers.

It will include the design and testing of an innovative risk management tool to increase smallholder farmers' resilience to climate change. In addition, knowledge management and capacity building focusing on beneficiaries and their needs will be supported to improve agricultural risk management.

## OBJECTIVE

To improve public policies aimed at increasing the climate resilience of family farming in Brazil through adaptation measures, such as crop insurance for small producers.
